## Overview

Laboratory skills required include blood sample processing and DNA extraction. This person will also be responsible for coordinating existing and new projects: including assistance with research permit applications and guidance of new trainees in the lab.

## Responsibilities

The technician will be expected to independently carry out essential research functions in the laboratory that include but are not limited to sample processing and DNA extraction. The technician should have excellent record keeping skills and a drive to learn new technologies. The technician will regularly meet with Dr. Madanat to discuss research progress and receive career guidance and mentorship. Experience in basic techniques in molecular biology is strongly preferred.

- design and execute standardized molecular, microbiological or biochemical experiments including collection of information and samples from blood and tissue
- analyze experimental data and interpret results to write reports and summaries of findings including grant preparation, presentations, and co-authored publications

- interact with local and international collaborators
